

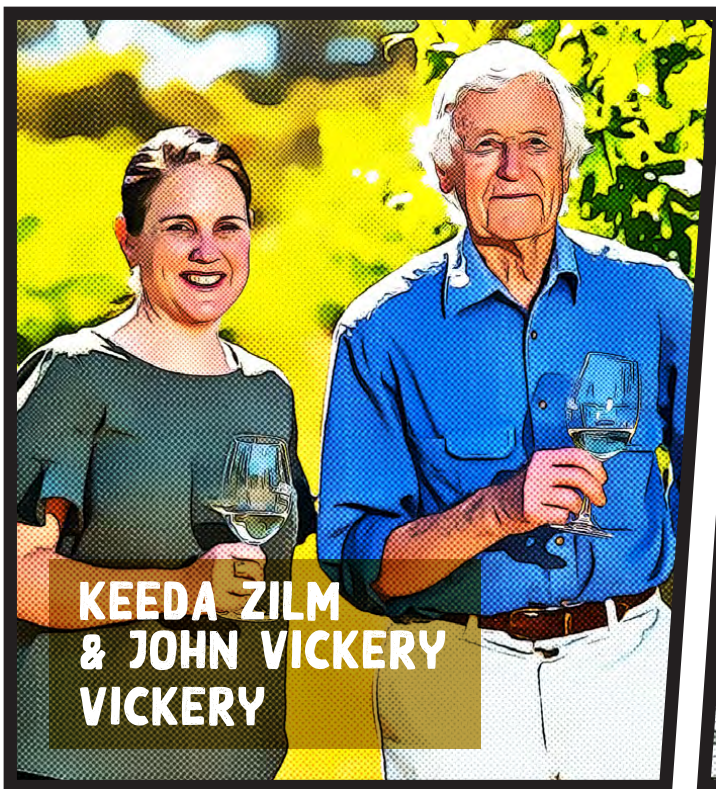

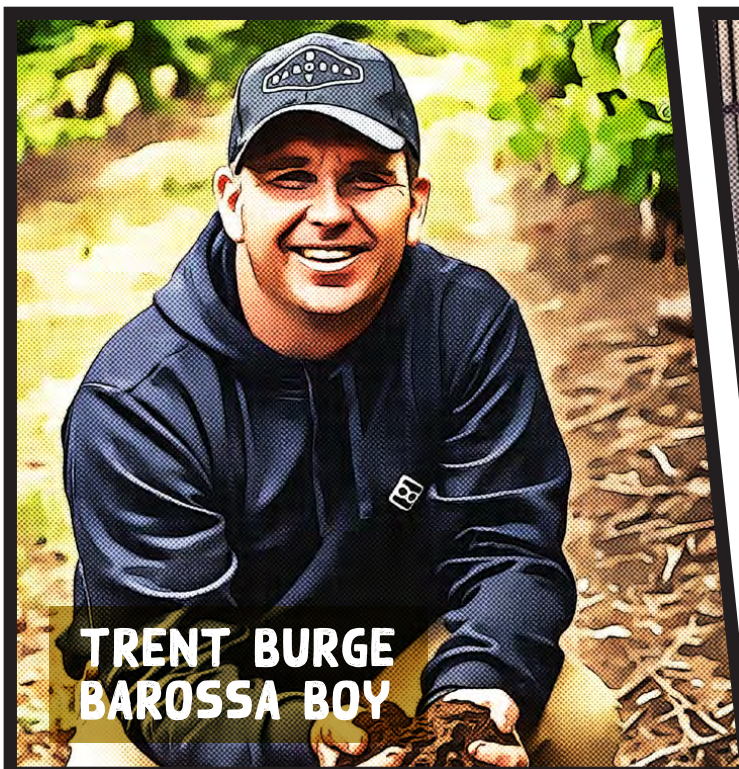

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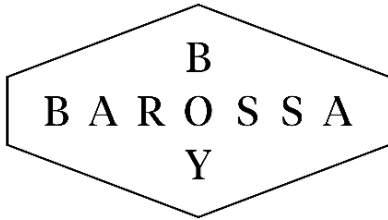
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The boy behind the wines is Trent Burge. His family’s history in the Barossa Valley goes back to 1855 when his great-great-great grandfather John Burge immigrated to South Australia. He began work as a winemaker, & every generation since has followed. Winemaking is well & truly in the Burge blood.

Involved in every aspect of grape growing & winemaking, Trent learnt the trade quite literally from the ground up. The craft, the Barossa region, its people & stories wove their magic. Trent’s passion for winemaking intensified, & in 2006 he officially joined the family business full-time. A vision for his own label grew. This sixth generation Barossa boy needed to make his own mark on the world. A particularly fine vintage in 2016 propelled plans into place, & Barossa Boy was born.

RECENT ACCOLADES:

2022 ‘Risk it for the Biscuit’ Semillon

92 pts - Sourced from over 100-yo Semillon vines in the Southern Barossa, the Barossa Boy version is quite ripe & aromatic, with a lovely mix of fruity (lemon, grapefruit, orange blossom, peach) & savoury shortbread characters. It’s zippy, minerally & silky, **a great example of Barossa Semillon.**

2020 ‘Double Trouble’ Shiraz Cabernet

94 pts - It’s a dark & spicy drop providing a tantalising array of aromas & flavours – cassis, menthol, mulberry, nutmeg, toast, cigar box, sawdust – a smooth & silky palate & finely integrated tannins, even at such a relatively young age. It has strength to age gracefully for a long time to come.

2020 ‘Young Wisdom’ Mataro






94 pts - A heady burst of fruit leaps from the bottle as soon as you open it, with blackberry & mulberry leading the charge. Savoury depth comes from tomato leaf, baking spices, earth & graphite, with a little bit of age starting to come through in the form of stewed black fruits. The palate is incredibly bright & tasty, and with spicy or meat-filled dishes; the fruit bellows while the alcohol mellows, showing great balance.

2017 ‘Lifeblood’ Shiraz

96 pts - Pronounced aromas of cassis, cinnamon & mulberry greeted me the moment I popped the cork, & further sniffs revealed raspberry, clove, leather & dried black fruits. The tannins are powdery & chewy, clinging to your teeth & letting you know just how epic this wine is. This is Trent’s “love letter” to the Barossa, & it’s a mighty fine tribute.

2023 'En Soleil' Pinot Gris

91 pts - A mix of stainless steel, concrete & acacia barrels add shape & dimension. It begins with glacé pears, golden apples & logans with hints of jonquil, candlenut & pineneedle. 2022 'The Aura' Cabernet Franc

Charlotte Hardy's Charlotte Dalton wines were launched from the 2015 vintage, a semillon & a shiraz made in an unfussed lo-fi way. With a career making wine for some serious labels, these weren't your classic new wave wines from Basket Range (Adelaide Hills). They were a pivot from the norm, unbound but not wild, essentially personal expressions. Hardy's wines are like that, made with technical understanding, but intuitively, a reflection of mood & moment.

Charlotte, & her wines, have been recognised with numerous major awards including winning the 2021 Young Gun of Wine, the Adelaide Review Hot 100 Wines, & a 5 red star rating in the Halliday Companion.

All wines are made with natural yeasts, minimal additions & bottled without fining or filtration in the winery Charlotte shares with partner Ben Cooke of Cooke Brothers Wines.

2022 'Fred' Fiano

93 pts - The ever-reliable fiano delivers the goods. This spent 4 months in used barriques. Passionfruit & blood orange flavours are unusual, but enjoyable thanks to the texture. James Halliday, Halliday, Jun '23

2022 'Grace' Chardonnay

93 pts - This is an excellent example of a non-mlf chardonnay, coaxed from a mid-weighted neutrality by a deft touch of skin contact, judicious lees work & a minimalist aura. Kudos! Pear drop, tatami straw & a rifle of aldehyde in the best sense. This is very good imminent drinking. Ned Goodwin MW, Halliday, Mar 23

2022 'Love Me Love you' Shiraz

93 pts - This is very good Adelaide Hills shiraz. The encroaching warmth of the region reverberates across palate-staining dark fruits as much as the cooler reductive handling & communicate of dried nori, olive smear & meaty bouillon lathers the finish. Cooke Brothers, under the gentle guiding hand of winemaker Ben Cooke, produce small batch, single vineyard, elegant, yet cellarable wines.

A previous Young Gun of Wine finalist, Ben is also a practicing viticulturalist. He works closely with a core group of growers who share a commitment to quality; careful pruning, restriction of yields, canopy manipulation, & sustainable practices, all aimed at producing the best possible fruit which is reflective of both site & vintage. Ben shares a winery & cellar door with partner Charlotte Hardy of Charlotte Dalton Wines.

2020 Deanery Vineyard Chardonnay

95 pts - Crushed, pressed, wild ferment, mlf & 12 mths' maturation in French puncheons (50% new). A well-composed wine, nicely coiled, releasing flinty grapefruit, lemon curd, white peach, nectarine & hazelnut oak. Creamy in texture, complex in delivery with juicy, chalky acidity. *Halliday Companion, Aug '22*

2021 Mataro Rose

93 pts - McLaren Vale mataro is the hero. I guess so are the Cooke Brothers. Lots going on in this rose. Jolly, raspberry & strawberry notes, some light, cashew notes, a sprinkle of cinnamon spice. Has length & texture, good energy & high drinkability on its side. A nice, slightly bitter-pickled cherry character emerges which delights too. Really interesting & good. *Huon Hooke, The Real Review, Apr '21*

2022 Savagnin

91 pts - Lanolin, candle wax, preserved lemon & a salty scape of gin & Mediterranean tonic. There is plenty to love here: the skiny architecture, the fractured pucker between a parched lip & the line of subtle fruit & the fill of the mid-palate, ineffable of character but present. A wine in the making. Already a lovely thing. Succulent, salty & driven to length & exclamation of more to come. *Ned Goodwin, Halliday, Jun '23*

2022 Single Vineyard Pinot Noir

92 pts - Deep-ish red-purple colour; Campari/Italian bitter herb aromas, definite whole-bunch/stalk components here, the palate elegantly cast, medium weight & neatly balanced, with medium length. A very attractive pinot that drinks well already. (1/3 whole bunch ferment) *Huon Hooke, The Real Review, Jul '23*

Eldorado is located in the Beechworth foothills equidistant between Beechworth & Wangaratta. The tiny home vineyards are located on Eldorado Road a few kms from the quaint hamlet of Eldorado. The property was selected & purchased principally because it's located on a seam of free draining red decomposed granite loaded with granite buckshot, flanked by granite hills & fed by the gentle flowing Reedy Creek which weaves its way through the property on its journey to the Ovens River.

Paul Dahlenburg (Bear) & Lauretta Schulz (Laurie) spent a career making wine & tending to the vineyards of others, although in 2010 Eldorado Road was born & they had their own label.

2019 Onyx Durif

96 pts - Durif re-imagined, courtesy of cool-climate elegance (Beechworth) mixed with a dose of generosity (Rutherglen) that needs to be tasted by every drinker who was ever scared witless by the grape. This is not scary, rather it's brilliantly delivered as a serious wine of some beauty: aromatic, blueberry, plum, dark chocolate & spice all lifted, fresh & plush. Bravo. Wine Companion, May '22

2019 Perseverance Old Vine Shiraz

97 pts - Only a meagre 1.8T of fruit was harvested from 6ha of old vines in 2019. That said, the concentration of fruit is truly extraordinary. Fi & Col Sheppard established Flaxman Wines in 2004 when they purchased the vineyard in the picturesque Eden Valley, Barossa, made the vine-change & moved across from Melbourne. The vineyard, planted in 1929, includes 3 acres of Riesling, 2.5 acres of Shiraz & 1/2 acre of Semillon. Small parcels of Grenache, Mataro, Chardonnay & Cabernet are also purchased from like-minded growers nearby to broaden the line-up of wines on offer. The grapes are hand-picked each year and all wines (except the Riesling) are made onsite.

2018 'The Stranger' Shiraz Cabernet

92 pts - A 62/38% blend of Barossa shiraz/Eden Valley cabernet, fermented separately & matured for 22 mths in 2nd & 3rd use barrels, American for the shiraz, French for the cabernet. A spacious & airy shiraz cabernet blend, with high-toned plum & blackcurrant fruit notes, some boysenberry & hints of spice box, licorice, dried herbs, espresso & oak. Plenty of detail & clarity on the palate, with a rose-petal-like high note, savoury line & lingering finish. **Dave Brookes, Wine Companion '23**

2016 Mataro

94 pts - Hand-picked, open-fermented, 10 days on skins, matured in third-use French oak for 24 months. The bouquet has spicy charcuterie nuances to the wild blackberry fruit of the medium-bodied palate. The tannins have been neatly handled, & the balance is good. Drink to 2031. **James Halliday, Wine Companion, Mar '22**

2018 'Double Up' Shiraz

95 pts - A 50% Barossa/50% Eden blend of 75 doz. Col Sheppard's control over alcohol & tannin levels is admirable, allowing the mix of blackberry & blackcurrant free play on the medium-bodied palate, oak along for the ride, tannins simply lengthening the finish. Drink to 2040. **James Halliday, Weekend Australian, Apr '22**

2018 Estate Shiraz

97 pts - The wine is worth every penny of its price. It is sublimely elegant, cherry all sorts riding on a bed of ultra-fine tannins. The production of 90 doz bottles from 80+ y.o. estate vines allows/demands scrupulous attention to detail at every step along the way & got it. A 6th generation vigneron hailing from the Barossa Valley, Nick Glaetzer cut his teeth in the cellars of his family's Glaetzer Wines while working vintages in Margaret River, the Hunter, the Pfalz region of Germany, Burgundy & Languedoc before a love of pinot noir drew him to Tasmania.

In 2008 he set up Glaetzer-Dixon Family Winemakers, initially sharing winemaking facilities at Frogmore Creek & Moorilla before moving to a purpose-built urban cellar in a former ice factory on the edge of Hobart's CBD.

Glaetzer-Dixon sources grapes from approx a dozen growers, mostly in the Coal River & Upper Derwent valleys in the south, & Tamar Valley in the north. Some of these growers were the pioneers of the Tasmanian wine industry, establishing their vineyards in the early 1970s. Nick has planted a 12ha vineyard at Tea Tree in the Coal River Valley, with the first harvest planned for 2024.

With Glaetzer-Dixon Nick has won the Jimmy Watson Memorial Trophy, Gourmet Traveller's Young Winemaker of the Year, & was named a Future 50 Winemaker by the Wine & Spirit Education Trust.

2020 Avancé Pinot Noir

Bright cherry & raspberry aromas continue to a full flavoured palate of fresh mixed red berries. Silky tannins & integrated acid balances & lengthens the delicious finish. *The Wine Advocate*

2018 Rêveur Pinot Noir

94 pts - Dark, lifted aromas of plums, old-school maraschino cherries & mixed spices. These characters intensify on the supple & fleshy palate, firmed by velvet tannins & a fine, balanced finish. *The Wine Advocate*

2018 Mon Pere Shiraz

95 pts - 2018 is the latest release and a world away from the very first Mon Pere 2008. Straight Outta Wine School should be the subtitle for the 2008, it's all precise, clean, easy to drink, very well made & ticks all the boxes but next to the 2018, the 2018 is exploding with personality. The funkiness comes from a mix of meatiness, horse leather, blackcurrants fresh off the bush, damsons, black cherries, dark chocolate, vanilla & spice. The tannin is soft & supple, balancing well with the refreshing acidity. Give it a while, like its predecessors, it is going to age very well indeed. *Curly Haslam-Coates, Winefront*

Hart & Hunter was created by winemaking couple, Jodie Belleville & Damien Stevens, with the ethos of sourcing the best parcels of fruit from outstanding sites in the Hunter to make distinctive, small batch, single vineyard wines. Working with highly regarded growers, their aim is to always credit the wine to the vineyard, in fact the latitude & longitude of each vineyard is proudly featured on their front labels.

In recent years they have allowed their creative side to take over by exploring wider regions & alternative varieties to create innovative wines outside of the classic Hunter varieties & styles.

RECENT ACCOLADES:

2021 75 Days Chardonnay

90 pts - The wine does what the label says & gives us a chardonnay from Hunter Valley that spends 75 days on skins before being pressed off & rested some more. Great to see this experimentation outta the noble Hunter region.

It dials up a lot of flavour & character, lemon curd, ripe apple, dried apple, honeycomb, pickled onion, ginger. Good characters here, a bit edgy in a decent way, quite waxy in texture, a little cloying through the finish but all up an interesting expression with plenty on for young (18+) & old. 2021 Shiraz Pinot

91 pts - This one has stewed fruit, cranberries & compote cherries, clove with orange spike, it's aromatic in the mouth, chewy with a pomegranate tang to finish. Tannins have a black tea grip. Higher Plane wines are truly single-vineyard & a reflection of their surroundings – a cool, southern pocket of Margaret River (Karridale) nestled within Karri forests 10km from the coast. The site is subject to the patterns of both Indian & Southern oceans - in particular the convergence of the two, resulting in cooler ripening periods giving both whites & reds a freshness & tension. Both the vineyard & winery are certified by the Sustainable Winemaking Australia organisation; the close-planted vineyard allows for more inter-vine competition & less vegetative growth, leading to better fruit quality.

Luc Fitzgerald, having worked alongside Mark Messenger since 2018, has recently taken over winemaking after helping to foster new wines focusing on innovative styles & varieties not usually associated with the region. The new look for Higher Plane better reflects the fresh & contemporary nature of the wines within.

2022 'Led Astray' Fume Blanc

95 pts - ...off a single vineyard in Karridale, whole-bunch pressed to tank, allowed to settle then popped into used French barriques for wild fermentation, regular lees stirring & on those lees for seven months. No wonder this is good. Really good. It has texture matched to flavour & complexity throughout. 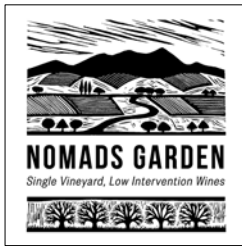

Nomads Garden wines are made by Paul & Ben Dahlenburg (from ★★★★★ producer, Eldorado Road), with fruit sourced from the five distinct, recognised wine regions of North East Victoria; King Valley, Alpine Valleys, Beechworth, Rutherglen & Glenrowan. Truly a nomadic winemaker’s dream garden.

The wines are intentionally not labelled or marketed as Natural Wines although the ethos in which they are made is very similar, believing the term “Natural” is far too ambiguous with no set guidelines dictating exactly what a natural wine is. Instead, they feel the term Low Intervention is a better description of what they are doing, creating single vineyard wines by hand, with no acid or enzyme additions, utilizing wild yeasts & a simple winemaking process that is transparently labelled on the back of the bottle. The wines stand up to conventionally made wines; low intervention is not an excuse for faulty or poor-quality wine!

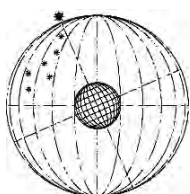

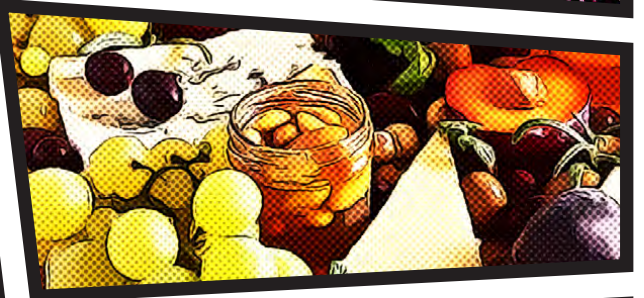
